




If All the Animals Came Inside by Eric Pinder


What the Animals Were Waiting For? by Jonathan London


Carnivores by Aaron Reynolds

When spring comes, Bear wakes up very hungry and is treated to great food by his friends.




Chu's Day by Neil Gaiman

Oh No! by Candace Fleming


A series of animals falls into a deep hole, only to be saved at last by a very large rescuer.




Animals Black and White





The Little Red Hen gives Old MacDonald some pointers on composting and a legendary farm is born in this rhyming, rollicking read-aloud.




Down by the Cool of the Pool by Tony Mitton



By King-Smith, Dick


121 pages. A collection of stories starring barnyard animals, including such characters as Babe the Pig, Lawrence the Cat and Ernest the Cow-Dog.




Just So Stories


Animal Crackers Fly the Coop By Kevin O'Malley


